

Operation – Game of Skill

Safety Instructions

Doctor, the patient is here to see you! And he's got a quite a few complaints, including a broken heart, water on the knee and butterflies in the stomach!

Use all your skill and coordination to remove the patient's "ailments" with the tweezers - without setting off the buzzer and making the patient's eyes light up! When that happens, it's time to call in a specialist!

1. Be sure that there is plenty of clearance between the player and spectators.
2. Keep spectators clear from the sides to prevent them from bumping or moving the table.
3. No leaning on the table.
4. NEVER USE THE GAME IN STRONG WINDS OR LIGHTENING!
5. Use caution when setting up or taking down the game. When flipping the game the weight may cause injury.
6. Use only the figures & tweezers included with the game.
7. DO NOT have food or drinks near game.

Assembly Instructions

1. Select a level area to operate game with plenty of room to allow for a line to form.
2. Assemble legs and snug the screws attached. Lift out of box and flip. Be sure that when you flip the game that the weight distribution changes and may cause injury.
3. Plug into standard outlet.
