

# SNO-KONE

## SET-UP AND OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS



### Cautions!

- **Never** put fingers or any object into the shaver body while the motor is running!
- **Never** let any metal get down in the gooseneck, or you will damage the machine.
- Machine must be properly grounded to prevent shock in case of electrical problems.
- During operation it is normal for the surface of the motor to become warm.
- **DO NOT** allow children to operate *Sno-Kone* machine!

### Sno-Kone MIX PREPARATION

1. Mix 3 - 4 pounds of sugar and 1 packet of *Sno-Kone* concentrate in 1 gallon of water.
2. Stir until all of the concentrate and sugar are dissolved. (Similar to mixing Kool-Aid or Lemonade.)
3. Pour contents into *Sno-Kone* jug provided. (Should you have mixture left over - store in refrigerator for later use.)
4. Insert pump into jug.

### OPERATION

1. Place *Sno-Kone* machine on a stable surface and plug the motor **directly** into a **grounded** power circuit.

**WARNING!** **DO NOT USE AN EXTENSION CORD!** UNIT MUST BE USED ONLY WITH DIRECT POWER!

2. When ready - start the motor. Fill the shaver gooseneck with ice cubes or block ice broken into pieces 3" to 4" in size. (**Never put fingers or any object into the shaver while the motor is running!**) Fill shaver gooseneck to about an inch or so from the top. *The larger the piece(s) of ice the better the snow.*
3. Push the pusher handle down to press the ice against the cutter head. A firm even pressure is all that is required, but sometimes you will find it better to relieve the pressure two or three times on the way down which allows the ice to rearrange itself and you get a better bite.
  - **Do Not Force The Handle** - the motor could stall!
  - Too much pressure on the pusher handle will make the ice come out coarse; too little pressure makes the ice mushy.
4. Scoop shaved ice into cones with provided ladle and top with prepared flavored syrup.
5. When finished wash out jug(s) with soap and water and wipe out ice collection area of *Sno-Kone* machine.

### Tips & Hints

- One 8 pound bag of ice chunks will shave enough ice to make approximately 20 - 25 *Sno-Kones*.
- Air Temperature influences the number of *Sno-Kones* produced.
- Get several flavors - the range of colors in the flavors can help make a very colorful event!
